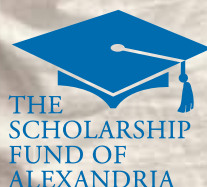

# In FAFSA BETA

**We are here to make sure students can understand their options.**

This fall, the Scholarship Fund of Alexandria was one of just six community-based organizations chosen from a nationwide pool of 80 to participate in the US Department of Education and Federal Student Aid Office's first beta testing period of the 2025-26 FAFSA. The SFA was then again selected for the fourth beta testing in November, allowing all ACHS seniors to apply early if they were ready. On October 2, nearly 100 ACHS students and families participated in the Beta 1 testing, submitting 94 FAFSA forms successfully. November 18 saw another 65 submitting forms early. This means that the SFA and our ACHS community have become essential parts of the progress toward a smoother 2025-2026 FAFSA for all high school seniors across the United States.

The Federal FAFSA Beta testing involved staff and volunteers from ACPs, NOVA, GMU, VCAC, NCAN, and Marymount University.

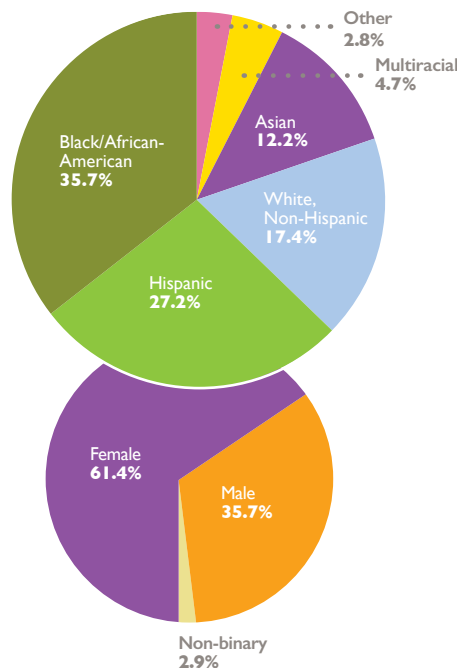

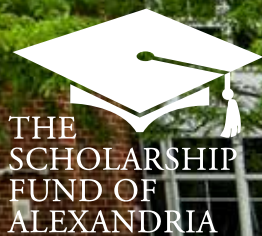

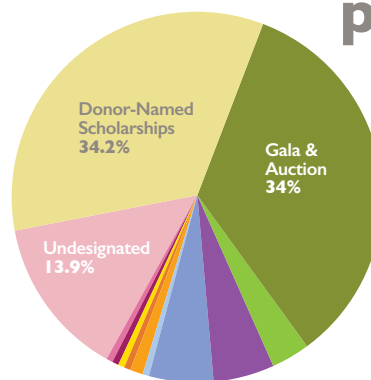
